Externally there are uncovered verandas and a swimming pool with bar area. It has double glazed windows, split units and a central heating system installed. The asset falls within planning zone ??6, with building density coefficient of 90%, coverage coefficient of 50%, in 2 floors and a maximum height of 10m.






